**ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR
EXTENSION OF TIME AND MOTION
TO EXPEDITE**

BEFORE THE COURT is Defendant Bureau of Indian Affairs’ (“BIA”) Motion for Extension of Time (ECF No. 334) and Motion to Expedite (ECF No. 337). Pursuant to this court’s Order of August 1, 2014 (ECF No. 329), the BIA was directed to notify this court and the individual Defendant landowners of its decision to appoint private legal counsel no later than September 22, 2014. The BIA contends its attorneys are still reviewing the requests for private representation and that the Solicitor’s Office at the Department of the Interior is still attempting to contact organizations potentially willing to provide representation. The BIA

1 anticipates the inquires can be completed and decisions and responses made by October 24,
2 2014 and requests an extension to that date.

3 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

4 1. Defendants' Motion for Extension of Time (ECF No. 334) is **GRANTED**.

5 2. Defendants' Motion to Expedite (ECF No. 337) is **GRANTED**.

6 3. Defendants shall respond to the court's Order of August 1, 2014 (ECF No. 329) on
7 or before **October 24, 2014**.

8 **IT IS SO ORDERED.** The Clerk of the court shall enter this Order and provide copies
9 to counsel, all pro se parties, and attorney Joseph Finley.
